

- 1. The Example of Abraham Let's see how Justified by faith works in a life. (Jewish forefather) Paul is saying; I am teaching you how this works by showing one of your own.
 - 1. Abraham cannot boast before God- What do we have to boast about? To the jew-there was boasting in their law keeping, or in their goodness in comparison to the gentiles (the world), Paul Boils it down- He might have had some things to boast about down here..but not before God.
 - 2. What does the Bible say? He believed God, and it was counted unto him as righteousness. "Abraham believed God [trusted God, banked on God's free mercy, looked away from his hopeless, ungodly self to God's grace] and that faith was credited to him as righteousness."DG
- 2. Who can be in?
 - God justifies the ungodly.- God grants faith to undeserving sinners. "Blessed is" be careful not to make faith a work to boast about Galatians 3:6–9[6] just as Abraham "believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"?[7] Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham. [8] And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed." [9] So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith. (ESV)
 - 2. The circumcised and the uncircumcised- again Abraham is the example-notice the order of events.
 - Abraham trusted God's promise to send a redeemer who would justify.
 - Then Abraham took on the mark of God's people. Abraham is the literal father of a nation, but he is also a spiritual founding father of the faithful.
 - 3. Those who like Abraham, have righteousness counted unto them by Fatih those who are numbered as part of God's people must be regenerate. (Born again) Abraham is "Father of" notes a relational connection among God's people- an identity

"Faith is not just what I assent to; it is also about whom I belong to. Faith is about family, a Christ shaped, Spirit filled, and God centered family... - 1. Boasting excluded- The Bible says the only thing we have to boast of is knowing Christ.
- 2. Get Baptized. the act (circumcision/ baptism) is not what saves, however it is important for God that his people be noted as his people. church-inspect and expect evidence of the new birth- be careful who you number among God's people.
- 3. Be a pop up book of God's grace- Is the grace at work in you, on display through you? Do you "believe God" that you can be forgiven by faith? How is that on display in your life?
