Intro

Greeters are instrumental in creating a welcoming & hospitable environment, because they are one of the first “faces” those attending on a Sunday will see. We have a great opportunity to show the love of Christ and share the heart of Aletheia Church to those who may be visiting for the first time. It’s also an opportunity to connect and follow up with returning visitors, regular attenders, and members.

Can you remember when you visited a new church for the first time? How can we use this opportunity to create a welcoming environment that feels desirable to enter into? The importance of being seen and welcomed cannot be overstated. It’s consistently the most mentioned thing people bring up in new member interviews when we ask why they are choosing to enter into membership with us.

How To Be An Effective Greeting Team Member:

- Sign up to serve via Planning Center (1x / month)
- Show up on time (9:40 a.m.)

Before The Service:

- Pray (*1 John 5:14–15*)
 - New guests
 - Conversions for those who don’t believe (*2 Corinthians 5.20*)
- Welcome (*Phil. 2.1-4*)
 - Make sure everyone is greeted
 - Look for those who may be new or who need direction (to the bathrooms, Aletheia Jr. check in, etc.)
- Hand out worship guides, point them toward the coffee table and / or resource shelf
- Connect

After The Service

- Follow up from service
- Direct to table resources or website (for additional contact info, events, etc.)
