### **Intro**

Through pouring coffee and offering the occasional snack, the hospitality team shows the love and servanthood of Christ and can make people feel more seen and at “home” within our gathering. Our team can use this time around the table to connect with our people - ask if they are new, if they’ve been coming for a while, how their week has been, etc. In the hustle of Sunday morning, we can slow down and connect with those around us.

### **How To Be An Effective Hospitality Team Member**

- **Pray for opportunities to connect**
- **Utilize Planning Center for service schedule (1x / month)**
- **Show up on time (9:00 AM)**
- **Stick around after the service to help clean up**
- **Engage with those around you by:**
  - **Offering a cup of coffee**
  - **Taking a moment to intentionally connect (*Philippians 2:1-11*)**
- **Identify and invite others to join our team - multiply!**

### **Before / During The Service:**

- **Set Up/Coffee Prep**
  - Start brewing both coffee makers as your first task (*each pot takes about a half hour to brew*)
  - Greet those who walk in, offer a cup of coffee
  - Get to know those who are coming up to the table (*ask them how they are, if they’re new, how their weekend was, etc.*)
  - Around 10:05, or when most people have arrived, start cleaning up the coffee pots. Utilize the faculty break room to dump out coffee and rinse out the pots
  - Pack up the “coffee cart” and leave out the cart for tear down team to put away

### **After The Service:**

- **Stick around and follow up with someone you met during the service!**
