The Aletheia Security Team exists to foster a secure and peaceful environment on Sunday mornings so that our church can gather to worship safely.

Intro

Each week at Aletheia Church, hundreds of members, regular attenders, and visitors from all over our community will gather to worship together. We also host an average of 75 children each week in Aletheia Jr. Our team has the opportunity to facilitate true worship in Spirit and truth by maintaining a safe environment where adults and children alike can engage with God with minimal anxiety or worry. We also serve as a helpful and welcoming presence. (*Romans 15.7*)

We, as a team, will remain vigilant and aware of circumstances which could require immediate attention, including:

- Fire / Medical emergencies
- Weather emergencies
- Active threat emergencies

How To Be An Effective Security Team Member:

- Pray for the service (before / during)
- Be available to serve on a regular basis (approximately 1x a month)
- Show up on time (9:30am)

Before the Service:

- Coordinate with the other Security Team Member for the morning.
- Conduct all necessary walk-throughs of the building, according to established procedures.
- Help greet members / guests as they walk into the building / check-in to Aletheia Jr.
- Observing and assessing anything which appears suspicious

During the service

- Lock the front door so that it only opens from the inside
- Be vigilant and maintain an awareness of both the inside and outside of the building for any suspicious activity
- Be available as the "Second Adult" in Aletheia Jr.; as needed
- Assist in calling for parents if there's a child that requires it
