Listen to this story from the Gospel of Matthew, "Then little children were being brought to him in order that he might lay his hands on them and pray. The disciples spoke sternly to those who brought them; but Jesus said, 'Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of heaven belongs.'"

God gives all of us jobs or vocations; things that we must do that help others and which serve God's kingdom. Finally, dear Lord, protect them from all illness and pain during this time of pandemic. This we pray in Jesus' name. Amen.
