

ETHICAL COMMITMENTS

- Information disclosed through prayer requests and in-person sessions is held in confidence by members of the prayer team of The Blessing Place at the Mission Abbey.
- Because every individual is known and beloved by God, we hold unconditional regard and
 respect for everyone with whom we pray. We do not judge, advise, or mandate directives
 to any who come to us for prayer. Prayer is offered with gentle respect and permission
 from recipients.
- Sessions are not to be considered professional therapy or counseling. Sessions are conducted by non-paid volunteers who engage in this ministry of prayer and blessing and are not to be considered professional therapy or counseling. Sessions are free of charge to all adults (18+) who, by their own volition, request such ministry sessions. Minors wishing prayer may come only with permission of a parent or guardian who accompanies them to the session.
- As required by law and duty to vulnerable others, any disclosure of physical abuse of minor children, elderly, or disabled persons will be reported to the appropriate authorities in a timely manner.
- Under the auspices of All Saints Anglican Church, Jackson, TN and its Rector, our prayer
 team honors the safety and wellbeing of all people. Verbal threats of imminent suicide or
 intent to harm others will require team members to respond with timely, responsible, and
 protective measures through contacting appropriate authorities. If allowed by the person
 in danger of self-harm, a safe and trusted family member or friend will be contacted for
 supportive care as well.
