



Prayer of the Covenant


Q. 16. Did all mankind fall in Adam's first transgression?

First Scripture Lesson

¹And David spoke to the LORD the words of this song on the day when the LORD delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul. ²He said,

"The LORD is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer,

- ³ my God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold and my refuge, my savior; you save me from violence.
- ⁴ I call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised,

and I am saved from my enemies.

- ⁵ "For the waves of death encompassed me, the torrents of destruction assailed me;
- ⁶ the cords of Sheol entangled me; the snares of death confronted me.
- ⁷ "In my distress I called upon the LORD; to my God I called.
- From his temple he heard my voice, and my cry came to his ears.
- ⁸ "Then the earth reeled and rocked; the foundations of the heavens trembled and quaked, because he was angry.
- ⁹ Smoke went up from his nostrils, and devouring fire from his mouth; glowing coals flamed forth from him.

- ¹⁰ He bowed the heavens and came down; thick darkness was under his feet.
- ¹¹ He rode on a cherub and flew; he was seen on the wings of the wind.
- ¹² He made darkness around him his canopy, thick clouds, a gathering of water.
- ¹³ Out of the brightness before him coals of fire flamed forth.
- ¹⁴ The LORD thundered from heaven, and the Most High uttered his voice.
- ¹⁵ And he sent out arrows and scattered them; lightning, and routed them.
- Then the channels of the sea were seen; the foundations of the world were laid bare, at the rebuke of the LORD, at the blast of the breath of his nostrils.
- ¹⁷ "He sent from on high, he took me; he drew me out of many waters.
- ¹⁸ He rescued me from my strong enemy, from those who hated me, for they were too mighty for me.
- ¹⁹ They confronted me in the day of my calamity, but the LORD was my support.
- ²⁰ He brought me out into a broad place; he rescued me, because he delighted in me.
- ²¹ "The LORD dealt with me according to my righteousness;
 - according to the cleanness of my hands he rewarded me.

- ²² For I have kept the ways of the LORD and have not wickedly departed from my God.
- ²³ For all his rules were before me, and from his statutes I did not turn aside.
- ²⁴ I was blameless before him, and I kept myself from guilt.

²⁵ And the LORD has rewarded me according to my righteousness,

according to my cleanness in his sight.

Second Scripture Lesson

¹⁹ Now when the virgins were gathered together the second time, Mordecai was sitting at the king's gate. ²⁰ Esther had not made known her kindred or her people, as Mordecai had commanded her, for Esther obeyed Mordecai just as when she was brought up by him. ²¹ In those days, as Mordecai was sitting at the king's gate, Bigthan and Teresh, two of the king's eunuchs, who guarded the threshold, became angry and sought to lay hands on King

Ahasuerus. ²² And this came to the knowledge of Mordecai, and he told it to Queen Esther, and Esther told the king in the name of Mordecai. ²³ When the affair was investigated and found to be so, the men were both hanged on the gallows. And it was recorded in the book of the chronicles in the presence of the king.
