



Children of all ages are invited to come forward and sit in front of the Communion Table for a lesson from the Elder.


Q. 21. Who is the redeemer of God's elect?

¹Now these are the last words of David: The oracle of David, the son of Jesse, the oracle of the man who was raised on high, the anointed of the God of Jacob, the sweet psalmist of Israel:

² "The Spirit of the LORD speaks by me; his word is on my tongue.

³ The God of Israel has spoken; the Rock of Israel has said to me:

When one rules justly over men, ruling in the fear of God,

⁴ he dawns on them like the morning light, like the sun shining forth on a cloudless morning,

like rain that makes grass to sprout from the earth.

⁵ "For does not my house stand so with God? For he has made with me an everlasting covenant,

ordered in all things and secure.

For will he not cause to prosper all my help and my desire?

⁶ But worthless men are all like thorns that are thrown away,

for they cannot be taken with the hand;

⁷ but the man who touches them arms himself with iron and the shaft of a spear,

and they are utterly consumed with fire."

Second Scripture Lesson

⁷ In the first month, which is the month of Nisan, in the twelfth year of King Ahasuerus, they cast Pur (that is, they cast lots) before Haman day after day; and they cast it month after month till the twelfth month, which is the month of Adar. 8 Then Haman said to King Ahasuerus, "There is a certain people scattered abroad and dispersed among the peoples in all the provinces of your kingdom. Their laws are different from those of every other people, and they do not keep the king's laws, so that it is not to the king's profit to tolerate them. 9 If it please the king, let it be decreed that they be destroyed, and I will pay 10,000 talents of silver into the hands of those who have charge of the king's business, that they may put it into the king's treasuries." 10 So the king took his signet ring from his hand and gave it to Haman the Agagite, the son of Hammedatha, the enemy of the Jews. ¹¹ And the king said to Haman, "The money is given to you, the people also, to do with them as it seems good to you."

¹² Then the king's scribes were summoned

on the thirteenth day of the first month, and an edict, according to all that Haman commanded, was written to the king's satraps and to the governors over all the provinces and to the officials of all the peoples, to every province in its own script and every people in its own language. It was written in the name of King Ahasuerus and sealed with the king's signet ring. 13 Letters were sent by couriers to all the king's provinces with instruction to destroy, to kill, and to annihilate all Jews, young and old, women and children, in one day, the thirteenth day of the twelfth month, which is the month of Adar, and to plunder their goods. 14 A copy of the document was to be issued as a decree in every province by proclamation to all the peoples to be ready for that day. 15 The couriers went out hurriedly by order of the king, and the decree was issued in Susa the citadel. And the king and Haman sat down to drink, but the city of Susa was thrown into confusion.
