





# First Scripture Lesson

<sup>1</sup> Draw near, O nations, to hear,  
and give attention, O peoples!  
Let the earth hear, and all that fills it;  
the world, and all that comes from it.

<sup>2</sup> For the LORD is enraged against all the nations,  
and furious against all their host;  
he has devoted them to destruction, has  
given them over for slaughter.

<sup>3</sup> Their slain shall be cast out,  
and the stench of their corpses shall rise;  
the mountains shall flow with their blood.

<sup>15</sup> There the owl nests and lays  
and hatches and gathers her young in her  
shadow;  
indeed, there the hawks are gathered,  
each one with her mate.

<sup>16</sup> Seek and read from the book of the LORD:  
Not one of these shall be missing;  
none shall be without her mate.  
For the mouth of the LORD has commanded,  
and his Spirit has gathered them.

<sup>17</sup> He has cast the lot for them;  
his hand has portioned it out to them with  
the line;  
they shall possess it forever;  
from generation to generation they shall  
dwell in it.

## Second Scripture Lesson

<sup>12</sup> The next day the large crowd that had come to the feast heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. <sup>13</sup> So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, crying out, “Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, even the King of Israel!” <sup>14</sup> And Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, just as it is written,

<sup>15</sup> “Fear not, daughter of Zion;  
behold, your king is coming,  
sitting on a donkey’s colt!”

<sup>16</sup> His disciples did not understand these things at first, but when Jesus was glorified, then they

remembered that these things had been written about him and had been done to him. <sup>17</sup> The crowd that had been with him when he called Lazarus out of the tomb and raised him from the dead continued to bear witness. <sup>18</sup> The reason why the crowd went to meet him was that they heard he had done this sign. <sup>19</sup> So the Pharisees said to one another, “You see that you are gaining nothing. Look, the world has gone after him.”
