


We use wine in the observance of the Lord's Supper as well as gluten-free bread.

First Scripture Lesson

- ¹ My son, if you receive my words and treasure up my commandments with you,
- ² making your ear attentive to wisdom and inclining your heart to understanding;
- ³ yes, if you call out for insight and raise your voice for understanding,
- ⁴ if you seek it like silver and search for it as for hidden treasures,
- ⁵ then you will understand the fear of the LORD and find the knowledge of God.

Second Scripture Lesson

Enter into the joy of your master.' ²⁴ He also who had received the one talent came forward, saying, 'Master, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you did not sow, and gathering where you scattered no seed, ²⁵ so I was afraid, and I went and hid your talent in the ground. Here, you have what is yours.' ²⁶ But his master answered him, 'You wicked and slothful servant! You knew that I reap where I have not sown and gather where I scattered no seed? 27 Then you ought to have invested my money with the bankers, and at my coming I should have received what was my own with interest. ²⁸ So take the talent from him and give it to him who has the ten talents. ²⁹ For to everyone who has will more be given, and he will have an abundance. But from the one who has not, even what he has will be taken away. ³⁰ And cast the worthless servant into the outer darkness. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'
