## First Scripture Lesson

- Hear, my son, and accept my words, that the years of your life may be many.
- <sup>11</sup> I have taught you the way of wisdom; I have led you in the paths of uprightness.
- <sup>12</sup> When you walk, your step will not be hampered,
  - and if you run, you will not stumble.
- <sup>13</sup> Keep hold of instruction; do not let go; guard her, for she is your life.
- <sup>14</sup> Do not enter the path of the wicked, and do not walk in the way of the evil.
- Avoid it; do not go on it; turn away from it and pass on.
- <sup>16</sup> For they cannot sleep unless they have done wrong;
  - they are robbed of sleep unless they have made someone stumble.
- <sup>17</sup> For they eat the bread of wickedness and drink the wine of violence.
- <sup>18</sup> But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn,
  - which shines brighter and brighter until full day.

- <sup>19</sup> The way of the wicked is like deep darkness; they do not know over what they stumble.
- My son, be attentive to my words; incline your ear to my sayings.
- 21 Let them not escape from your sight; keep them within your heart.
- <sup>22</sup> For they are life to those who find them, and healing to all their flesh.
- 23 Keep your heart with all vigilance, for from it flow the springs of life.
- Put away from you crooked speech, and put devious talk far from you.
- Let your eyes look directly forward, and your gaze be straight before you.

## Second Scripture Lesson

<sup>30</sup> And when they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives. <sup>31</sup> Then Jesus said to them, "You will all fall away because of me this night. For it is written, 'I will strike the shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered.' <sup>32</sup> But after I am raised up, I will go before you to Galilee." <sup>33</sup> Peter answered him, "Though they all fall away because of you, I will never fall away." <sup>34</sup> Jesus said to him, "Truly, I tell you, this very night, before the rooster crows, you will deny me three times." <sup>35</sup> Peter said to him, "Even if I must die with you, I will not deny you!" And all the disciples said the same.

<sup>36</sup> Then Jesus went with them to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to his disciples, "Sit here, while I go over there and pray." <sup>37</sup> And taking with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, he began to be sorrowful and troubled. <sup>38</sup> Then he said to them, "My soul is very sorrowful, even to death; remain here, and watch with me." <sup>39</sup> And going a little farther he

fell on his face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will." <sup>40</sup> And he came to the disciples and found them sleeping. And he said to Peter, "So, could you not watch with me one hour? 41 Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak." <sup>42</sup> Again, for the second time, he went away and prayed, "My Father, if this cannot pass unless I drink it, your will be done." 43 And again he came and found them sleeping, for their eyes were heavy. 44 So, leaving them again, he went away and prayed for the third time, saying the same words again. 45 Then he came to the disciples and said to them, "Sleep and take your rest later on. See, the hour is at hand, and the Son of Man is betrayed into the hands of sinners. 46 Rise, let us be going; see, my betrayer is at hand."
