





Prayer for Illumination

# First Scripture Lesson

- <sup>1</sup> My son, be attentive to my wisdom; incline your ear to my understanding,
- <sup>2</sup> that you may keep discretion, and your lips may guard knowledge.
- <sup>3</sup> For the lips of a forbidden woman drip honey, and her speech is smoother than oil,
- <sup>4</sup> but in the end she is bitter as wormwood, sharp as a two-edged sword.
- <sup>5</sup> Her feet go down to death; her steps follow the path to Sheol;

# Second Scripture Lesson
