I believe in God the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.



First Scripture Lesson

- ²¹ How the faithful city has become a whore, she who was full of justice!
- Righteousness lodged in her, but now murderers.
- ²² Your silver has become dross, your best wine mixed with water.
- Your princes are rebels and companions of thieves.
- Everyone loves a bribe and runs after gifts.
- They do not bring justice to the fatherless, and the widow's cause does not come to them.
- Therefore the Lord declares, the LORD of hosts, the Mighty One of Israel:
- "Ah, I will get relief from my enemies and avenge myself on my foes.
- ²⁵ I will turn my hand against you and will smelt away your dross as with lye and remove all your alloy.

Second Scripture Lesson

¹² But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, ¹³ who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

¹⁴ And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. ¹⁵ (John bore witness about him, and cried out, "This was he of whom I said, 'He who comes after me ranks before me, because he was before me."") ¹⁶ For from his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace. ¹⁷ For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. ¹⁸ No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.
