
I believe in God the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth.

First Scripture Lesson

- ¹ The oracle concerning Babylon which Isaiah the son of Amoz saw.
- ² On a bare hill raise a signal; cry aloud to them; wave the hand for them to enter the gates of the nobles.
- ³ I myself have commanded my consecrated ones,

and have summoned my mighty men to execute my anger, my proudly exulting ones.

- ⁴ The sound of a tumult is on the mountains as of a great multitude!
- The sound of an uproar of kingdoms, of nations gathering together!
- The LORD of hosts is mustering a host for battle.
- ⁵ They come from a distant land, from the end of the heavens,
- the LORD and the weapons of his indignation, to destroy the whole land.
- ⁶ Wail, for the day of the LORD is near; as destruction from the Almighty it will come!
- ⁷ Therefore all hands will be feeble, and every human heart will melt.
- ⁸ They will be dismayed: pangs and agony will seize them; they will be in anguish like a woman in labor.

They will look aghast at one another; their faces will be aflame.

- ⁹ Behold, the day of the LORD comes, cruel, with wrath and fierce anger, to make the land a desolation and to destroy its sinners from it.
- ¹⁰ For the stars of the heavens and their constellations

will not give their light; the sun will be dark at its rising, and the moon will not shed its light.

- ¹¹ I will punish the world for its evil, and the wicked for their iniquity;
- I will put an end to the pomp of the arrogant, and lay low the pompous pride of the ruthless.
- ¹² I will make people more rare than fine gold, and mankind than the gold of Ophir.
- ¹³ Therefore I will make the heavens tremble, and the earth will be shaken out of its place, at the wrath of the LORD of hosts in the day of his fierce anger.
- ¹⁴ And like a hunted gazelle, or like sheep with none to gather them, each will turn to his own people, and each will flee to his own land.
- ¹⁵ Whoever is found will be thrust through, and whoever is caught will fall by the sword.
- Their infants will be dashed in pieces before their eyes;

their houses will be plundered and their wives ravished.

¹⁷ Behold, I am stirring up the Medes against them,

who have no regard for silver and do not delight in gold.

Their bows will slaughter the young men; they will have no mercy on the fruit of the womb;

their eyes will not pity children.

¹⁹ And Babylon, the glory of kingdoms, the splendor and pomp of the Chaldeans, will be like Sodom and Gomorrah when God overthrew them.

²⁰ It will never be inhabited or lived in for all generations; no Arab will pitch his tent there; no shepherds will make their flocks lie down there.

²¹ But wild animals will lie down there, and their houses will be full of howling creatures;

there ostriches will dwell, and there wild goats will dance.

Second Scripture Lesson

30 "I can do nothing on my own. As I hear, I judge, and my judgment is just, because I seek not my own will but the will of him who sent me. 31 If I alone bear witness about myself, my testimony is not true. ³² There is another who bears witness about me, and I know that the testimony that he bears about me is true. ³³ You sent to John, and he has borne witness to the truth. ³⁴ Not that the testimony that I receive is from man, but I say these things so that you may be saved. 35 He was a burning and shining lamp, and you were willing to rejoice for a while in his light. ³⁶ But the testimony that I have is greater than that of John. For the works that the Father has given me to accomplish, the very works that I am doing, bear witness about me that the Father has sent me. ³⁷ And the Father who sent me has himself borne witness about me. His voice you have never heard, his form you have never seen, 38 and you do not have his word

abiding in you, for you do not believe the one whom he has sent. 39 You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about me, 40 yet you refuse to come to me that you may have life. 41 I do not receive glory from people. 42 But I know that you do not have the love of God within you. ⁴³ I have come in my Father's name, and you do not receive me. If another comes in his own name, you will receive him. 44 How can you believe, when you receive glory from one another and do not seek the glory that comes from the only God? 45 Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father. There is one who accuses you: Moses, on whom you have set your hope. 46 For if you believed Moses, you would believe me; for he wrote of me. 47 But if you do not believe his writings, how will you believe my words?"
