

HOW CAN I SHARE THE GOSPEL?

Six Practical Ways to Help You Get Started

Too often, we find ourselves unprepared to share our faith. You might be afraid of saying the wrong thing or afraid of even starting a conversation. Before you know it, a great opportunity for evangelism has passed. Here are 5 practical ways to help you get started.

1. Consider your Circle of Influence. What does it look like for YOU to share the gospel with them? These could be neighbors, co-workers, or family members. Pray that the Lord will open doors.
2. Pick up a Recommended Book. As a resource and to giveaway, consider Honest Evangelism by Rico Tice, The Case for Christ by Lee Strobel, Tell the Truth by Will Metzger, or The Gospel Uncompromised by Billy King.



3. Invite Others to Church and Christianity Explored (CE). In worship and in a CE class, people will hear the message of the gospel.
4. Consider Your Spiritual Gifts. Discover your unique spiritual gifts with the assessment tool titled “Becoming a Contagious Christian” linked on the QR code below. Each of us is gifted differently to help share the gospel.
5. Evangelism Partner. Have someone who encourages you in evangelism and will pray for you when you are sharing with others.
6. Take the Plunge. Bring up the subject of the gospel with a friend or ask a “gospel leading” question and see where the conversation goes.
