Sermon Meditations: Servants and Messengers

Monday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 13:1-20; Philippians 2:1-11
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's first point was "Christ's Selfless Service". It's shocking how far Christ humbled himself to serve us! John tells us this is the love of Christ for his own. And Christ's example of foot washing points to the even more shocking act of dying on the cross in our place and for our sins. Paul makes the point in Romans 8:32 that having died for us, what WON'T he give us! Christian, you are infinitely loved by God! This should draw from us praise and worship and thanksgiving.

Tuesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 13:1-20
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's second point was "Our Selfless Service". Christ, having set this example, now calls all of his disciples to follow it in service to one another. The truth is quite clear: None of us is as great as Christ. And none of us can humble ourselves as low as he did. Therefore, the call to follow his example is a radical call! We love as Christ loves and therefore serve as Christ served. What are some ways you've resisted selfless service? What are some ways you can selflessly serve this week?

Wednesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 13:1-20
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's third point was "From Confidence to Blessing". Christ's service is offered with confidence and results in blessing. This same confidence and blessing belong to us. What can stop us from serving selflessly? How can this confidence and blessing spur us on to good works in Christ Jesus?

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 13:21-30
- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

Friday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 13:21-30
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
