**Instruction:** Whatever time of day works best each day for you or your family, use the prompts below to spend a few minutes together in prayer and the Word. Open and close each session with a simple prayer. Use the questions for meditation or discussion.

**Sermon Meditations: Becoming A Disciple of Christ**

Monday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 1:35-42
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's first point was "Step 1: Believe the Gospel". John saw Jesus as he was walking by and pointed him out to his disciples. He once again said, "Behold the Lamb of God." The disciples heard John and followed Christ. The witness of John is, "Jesus is the Lamb of God." The necessary response is to believe. What does it mean to believe in Christ? What is the necessary action on our part to become a Christian? What is Christ's role in our salvation?

Tuesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 1:35-42
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's second point was "Step 2: Follow Christ". Andrew and the other disciple leave John and go after Christ. Jesus looks at them and asks, "What are you seeking?" What are you seeking from Christ? What does Jesus' invitation to the disciples teach us about him? How may we spend time with Jesus today?

Wednesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 1:35-42
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's third point was "Step 3: Tell Others About Christ". After being alone with Jesus, the disciples are fully convinced that he is the Messiah. What is Andrew's first action after his encounter with Jesus? What does their action teach us is a necessary part of being a disciple? Are the 3 steps of being a disciple of Christ present in your life? What ways can you encourage others to be true disciples of Christ?

- Read: John 1:43-51
- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

- Read: John 1:43-51
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
