Sermon Meditations: A Magnification of His Presence

Monday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 14:15:17
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's first point was "The Test of Love". Throughout Jesus' discourse with his disciples, he is seeking to give them comfort and peace for his imminent death and departure from them. Previously, he told them that he gives himself to them. Now he seeks to impress upon them the marks of truly being his disciples. Why does obedience relate to love in vs. 15? How can we wrongly view our obedience regarding his love? How does obedience convey our conviction of who Christ is to us?

Tuesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 14:15-17
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's second point was "The Helper". If we love Christ we will obey him. Why are we in need of a Helper? Who is the Helper? How is the Helper related to the Father and the Son? What encouragement does it give us that Christ promises a Helper that will never leave us? What help do we receive from the Holy Spirit?

Wednesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 14:15-17
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's third point was "Union with Christ". The Holy Spirit is called the Spirit of Truth. What truth does the Spirit reveal to us? Why can the world not know this truth? How does the Spirit help us to see and know Christ? How is the Spirit a magnification of Christ's presence with us? What are the practical ways in which the Spirit helps us in the world as we wait for Jesus to return?

- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
