Instruction: Whatever time of day works best each day for you or your family, use the prompts below to spend a few minutes together in prayer and the Word. Open and close each session with a simple prayer. Use the questions for meditation or discussion.

Sermon Meditations: Bearing God's Image

Monday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 1:26-31
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's first point on Sunday was "Made in His Image: We are God's Regents in the World." Being made in the image and likeness of God is ultimately about being his representative in the world. How are we called to represent God? What are some practical ways we can do this each day?
- Close in prayer.

Tuesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 1:26-31
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's second point on Sunday was "Given Dominion: A Call to Serve and Submit." Humanity is not merely another part of God's creation, but is the pinnacle of it! If the one who made all things and has all authority gives us dominion, then how are we to use that authority? What are some practical ways we can do that this week?
- Close in prayer.

Wednesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 1:26-31
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's third point on Sunday was "Utterly Dependent: Life Given and Sustained by God." What are some of the ways we are dependent upon God? What does God reveal about himself by providing what we need?
- Close in prayer.

Preparing Our Hearts to Receive the Word

Thursday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 1:1-2:3 (or 1:1-19)
- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?
- Close in Prayer

Friday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 1:1-2:3 (or 1:20-2:3)
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior?
- Close in Prayer

Note: Gen 1:1-2:3 might be more reading than you have time for during this family worship each day. If so, perhaps divide it into two readings, one for Thursday and one for Friday. We will be reading these verses for the next several weeks, so you should become quite familiar with them.
