Sermon Meditations: My Peace I Give to You

Monday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 14:25-31
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's first point was "The Helper's Role". Jesus has been giving the disciples a lot of instruction. The challenge is whether or not they will remember it when he is gone. Jesus indicates two of the roles the Helper will serve in their lives. What are they? What does 'all things' mean? Does 'all things' mean we will understand every aspect of life? What role does the Spirit serve in remembering and what role do we have in order to remember?

Tuesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 14:25-31
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's second point was "The Helper's Peace". The Holy Spirit gives us the peace of Jesus. What peace may we have different than the world? How does the world seek to be a peace? Looking over the whole of chapter 14, what things has Jesus promised that should give us peace? Jesus said do not be troubled or afraid. What should we do when we feel troubled or afraid?

Wednesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 14:25-31
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's third point was "So That You May Believe". Jesus has told the disciples everything that is going to happen to him and what is to come for them. Jesus doesn't promise that the Christian life will be easy. What does he promise? If the ruler of the world has no claim on Jesus, what does this mean for the Christian as well? What encouragement does Jesus give us as he rises and goes toward the cross?

- Read: Ezekiel 37:1-14
- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

- Read: Ezekiel 37:1-14
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
