Sermon Meditations: Stronger Hope and Sure

Monday

- Open in prayer
- Read: 1 Peter 1:1-12
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's first point was "Our salvation is all of God - it is in accordance with God's great mercy." Take a moment to discuss God's mercy – why do we need God to be merciful? How is he merciful to us?
- Close in prayer

Tuesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: 1 Peter 1:1-12
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's second point was "Our salvation is all of God - he has caused us to be born again." How is this a resurrection for us? What does it mean to us that God caused it?
- Close in prayer

Wednesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: 1 Peter 1:1-12
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's third point was "Our salvation is all of God - he has brought it about through Christ's resurrection." If God brought it about through Christ's resurrection, what does that tell us about the certainty of our own resurrection? Is God powerful enough to resurrect us? Is he faithful to do so?

Thursday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: 1 Peter 1:1-12
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's fourth point was "Our salvation is all of God - he guards us through faith until Christ comes again." If we died once, even though he's resurrected us from that death, couldn't we die again? What comfort is it to us that God himself guards us?

Friday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 28:10-22
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
