- Read: Read Revelation 19:1-5, Proverbs 1:7
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's first point Sunday was "The Just Judgment of God." How is God's salvation related to his judgment in these verses? How does this warning of the end instruct believers today about their sin? What does it mean to fear the Lord in vs. 5?
- Close in Prayer

Tuesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Revelation 19:6-8
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's second point was "Love Drives Christ To the Sinner." Why is Christ referred to as Lamb in this passage? What does it teach us about the love of Christ for his church in this passage? How are we to express our love back to Christ?
- Close in Prayer

Wednesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Revelation 19:6-10,
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's third point on Sunday was "Blessed are Those Who Are Invited." Who may come to the Marriage Feast of Christ? How is the invitation received unto salvation? What does it mean to have faith and repentance and why must these always go together?
- Close in Prayer

- Read: Judges 10:17-11:28
- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

Friday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Judges 10:17-11:28
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior?
