Sermon Meditations: Mission Accomplished

Monday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 17:1-8
- Meditation: Mr. Jeremy's first point was "The Son's mission." Jesus' mission was to fill the earth with the glory of God. In accomplishing this mission, he does what Adam failed to do. How has Jesus accomplished this mission (see Phil. 2:5-8)? How can you find encouragement in knowing Jesus' mission is accomplished? As a follower of Christ, how do you partake in his mission?

Tuesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 17:1-8
- Meditation: Mr. Jeremy's second point was "The words of life." Jesus says the disciples have eternal life by receiving the words that reveal who he is and the mission he came to accomplish. Where do we find these words? Why is it impossible to have eternal life in Christ apart from these words? Read John 6:68-69. Even when the Bible is hard to understand or difficult to believe, why should we not let them go?

Wednesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 17:1-8
- Meditation: Mr. Jeremy's third point was "This is eternal life." Jesus says that eternal life is knowing the only true God through Jesus Christ. If you have faith in Jesus and trust in the work he has accomplished for you, you have eternal life now. How does this change your perspective about the things of this life (the things you own, the desires you have, your hopes for the future, etc.)? How can you help others know this eternal life?

- Read: John 17:9-19
- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

Friday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 17:9-19
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
