Sermon Meditations: Bigger Than God

Monday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 4:17-24
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's first point on Sunday was "The offspring of the serpent serve themselves and trust in their own power." What are some ways we see the world behaving like Cain and his children today?
- Close in prayer.

Tuesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 4:25-26; Matthew 18:21-22
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's second point on Sunday was "The offspring of Eve trust in God." How did Eve trust in God in 4:25? How are some ways we can trust in God today instead of trusting in ourselves and our own power and wisdom? How does Matthew 18 relate to our passage?
- Close in prayer.

Wednesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 4:25-26
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's third point on Sunday was "The offspring of Eve serve God." What are some specific ways God has blessed you that you can use to serve him rather than yourself?
- Close in Prayer

- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

Friday

- Open in Prayer

- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior?
