**Sermon Meditations: Kept by the Father**

**Monday**

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 17:9-19
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's first point was "Our Privileged Place". Jesus says he is not praying for the world, but for those who believe – those who are his. Jesus' intercessory work is a privilege of the Christian! Christ prays for us. He intercedes for us. And the Father always hears and answers the prayers of his Son. What an encouragement to us, his people! Give thanks to God today for the work of Christ on our behalf.

**Tuesday**

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 17:9-19
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's second point was "Our Blessed Assurance". Jesus' request of the Father is that he would keep us in his name. We are held in the faith by the Father who loves us. We are protected from the evil one by the Father to whom we belong. Nothing can snatch us out of his hand! What blessed assurance!

**Wednesday**

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 17:9-19
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's third point was "Our Mission to the World". Jesus prays for us – that we would be kept – because we are his; because he loves us; and because we are on mission, sent by Jesus into the world with the word of God – the word given by the Father to the Son, who has faithfully given that word to us and sent us out to proclaim it. It is a mission that may require everything of us. Nothing is too much for the Father and Son to ask of us. Are we fulfilling this calling? Are we preparing for the mission by training in godliness? By faithfully fulfilling the mission in our homes and families? By looking for and creating opportunities in the places we live, work, play, and rest?

- Read: John 17:9-19
- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

- Read: John 17:9-19
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
