Monday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Judges 16:31; Revelation 19:11-16
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's first point Sunday was "Jesus Christ is the judge of all." Do you have difficulty thinking of Christ as a judge? How is his role as judge good news to believers?
- Close in Prayer

Tuesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Judges 16:28-30; 1 Corinthians 15:20-26
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's second point was "Jesus Christ destroys all his and our enemies." Scripture defines who our enemies are and we must be careful to follow that definition. Who are our enemies according to Scripture?

Wednesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Judges 16:30; Hebrews 2:14-15; Romans 8:33-34
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's third point on Sunday was "Jesus Christ defeated death with death." We were sentenced to death because of sin. Jesus Christ died in our place. We are no longer subject to the sentence of death. There is no double jeopardy with God. Meditate on this good news and in prayer, give thanks to God.

- Read: Judges 17
- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

Friday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Judges 17
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior?
