Sermon Meditations: They Saw...and They Took

Monday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 6:1-8
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's first point on Sunday was "Mankind's greatest problem is sin." What kind of problems attract most of your attention? When Christ returns and judges the earth, what will his judgment be against sin? How can we avoid that judgment?
- Close in prayer.

Tuesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 6:1-8
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's second point on Sunday was "God's just response to sin is death." How does God respond to the sin described in Genesis 6:1-8? How is this just? If this is how God responds to sin, then how should we, as his children, view sin – especially our own sin?
- Close in prayer.

Wednesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 6:1-8
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's third point on Sunday was "God will not abandon his plan or his people." What hope do we have as sinners in the world when this is how God responds to sin? What has God promised? How has he shown himself faithful in history to keep his promises?
- Close in Prayer

- Read: Genesis 6:9-7:24
- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?
- Close in Prayer

Friday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 6:9-7:24
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior?
