Instruction: Whatever time of day works best each day for you or your family, use the prompts below to spend a few minutes together in prayer and the Word. Open and close each session with a simple prayer. Use the questions for meditation or discussion.

Sermon Meditations: The Words of Eternal Life

Monday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 6:60-71
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's first point was "Why is the gospel an offensive message"? Jesus has just finished speaking in the clearest terms to the people that he is the Son of God, come from heaven, to provide eternal life. He also told them that they must feed upon his flesh and blood. This word challenged those who followed him and caused offense. Why is the truth of the gospel message hard for people to believe? What demands does the gospel make upon our lives? Why is the flesh no help when it comes to our salvation? How do we spiritually feed upon Christ?

Tuesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 6:60-71
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's second point was "What will you do when you meet Jesus"? Jesus understands that the people are struggling to believe his message. He then asks them, "What if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before?" The people have been judging Jesus according to his words and now Jesus asks them what they will do when he sits in judgment over them from his throne. Why is this a question we must all answer? Jesus says, "The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life". How are we to respond to Jesus words now? What does Jesus say we must do to be saved?

Wednesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 6:60-71
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's third point was "Where else can you go for eternal life"? When Jesus asks his disciples if they want to leave, they give a different response than the people. They acknowledge there is nowhere else to go for eternal life and they said they believe he is the Holy One of God. What is the simplicity of this response? How does their answer differ from the lies of this world? What is our assurance now that we know Christ and have received eternal life?

- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 7:1-13
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of

man.” What does this passage teach us about God’s character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
