Sermon Meditations: The God of the Nations

Monday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 10:1-32
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's first point was "God is gracious." How does vs. 1 reveal that God is gracious? How has he shown himself gracious towards these nations in this chapter? How has he shown himself gracious to the nations through Christ?
- Close in prayer

Tuesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 10:1-32 also Romans 2:4-5 or 2 Peter 3:8-10
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's second point was "God is patient." Why is God so patient with sinners? How should we respond to God's patience towards us in our sin?
- Close in prayer

Wednesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Genesis 10:1-32
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's third point was "God is sovereign." What comfort should we draw from the sovereignty of God over the nations? As God records for us the names of the nations how do we fit into this story? What concern does the bible say we should have for the nations? How does Christ bring us together into one family?

- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior?
