Sermon Meditations: Examining the Lamb

Monday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 18:38b-19:7
- Meditation: Mr. Jeremy's first point was "The World Examined." In this passage, we see the behavior of the Gentiles and the Jews toward Jesus. What are some of the ways these two groups show themselves to be sinful and guilty? What do their actions prove that they need?
- Close in prayer

Tuesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 18:38b-19:7
- Meditation: Mr. Jeremy's second point was "The Lamb Examined." Pilate proclaimed three times that he found no guilt in Jesus. Why was it necessary for Jesus to be blameless and perfect? How is this like the Passover lamb? How did Jesus' sufferings make him perfect?

Wednesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 18:38b-19:7
- Meditation: Mr. Jeremy's third point was "The Lord Provides." Here, we see the people's need met by the perfect Lamb, Jesus Christ. In the Passover, what happened to the firstborn in Egypt when the Lord passed over the land? What happened in the houses where the blood of the lamb had been painted on the doorposts? In what ways does Jesus fulfill this for us?

- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

- Read: John 19:8-11
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
