Sermon Meditations: Who Will You Serve?

Monday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 19:8-16a; Acts 2:22-24
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's first point was "The Faithful King". In verse 11 Jesus points to the higher authority to which even Pilate must submit. Christ himself has submitted to this authority. He is the Passover Lamb who is sacrificed for our sin, to save us! He does this willingly because he loves the Father and he loves us. This is a King worth serving! Worthy is the Lamb who was slain!

Tuesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 19:8-16a
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's second point was "What king do you serve?" Everyone in this passage is serving themselves except Jesus. Is Jesus your King? Do you serve and obey him? When faced with the choice between what you want and that to which Christ calls you, do you lay down your will and submit to him?

Wednesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Joshua 24:15; Isaiah 53:4-8; Acts 2:22-24; John 1:29; Revelation 5:12
- Meditation: For this Wednesday, read the above passages and meditate upon Christ as our Passover Lamb and our Worthy King. Give thanks to him.
- Close in prayer

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 19:16b-30
- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

Friday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 19:16b-30
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
