**Sermon Meditations:** Seeking Christ

Monday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 7:25-36
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's first point was "The World Cannot Know God Apart from Jesus Christ." Knowing God is what matters. He can only be known through faith and therefore fellowship with Jesus Christ. We must receive Christ as he is offered to us in the gospel in order to have life-giving fellowship with the Father.

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 7:25-36
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's second point was "The World Cannot Stop God." God's mission will not be threatened or defeated. Our salvation is certain. Everything unfolds according to God's perfect plan. Christian, be comforted in this!

Wednesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 7:25-36
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's third point was "The time is short – what will you do?" Every person must respond to the message of the gospel. You will either hear this message and reject it or hear this message and believe it, trusting in Christ alone for your salvation. There is hope in no other name under heaven! What will you do?

- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
