**Instruction:** Whatever time of day works best each day for you or your family, use the prompts below to spend a few minutes together in prayer and the Word. Open and close each session with a simple prayer. Use the questions for meditation or discussion.

**Sermon Meditations:** Seek That You May Escape

Monday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 8:12-20
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's first point was "Where are you going?" Jesus tells the Jews that he is going away and that they will die in their sins. He also tells them that where he is going, they cannot come unless they believe in him. What problem do we have that we cannot overcome? Why do we have to believe the truth that Jesus reveals in order to be saved? How do we seek Christ and how is he found?

Tuesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 8:12-20
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's second point was "Who is he?" The Jews ask the question, "Who are you?" Jesus doesn't answer with new information but says he has told them everything since the beginning. Jesus has told us in his word who he is and what he gives unto us. List the things that Jesus has revealed about himself. What are we required to do in order to be saved from sin and death?

Wednesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 8:12-20
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's third point was "What has Jesus revealed?" Jesus tells the Jews that they will recognize who he is when he has been lifted up. What is revealed about Jesus at the cross? Why is the cross central to our salvation? How does Jesus work on the cross make him judge over all mankind? We will all meet Jesus one day, believer and unbeliever. What will be the difference between the believer and the unbeliever on the day we all meet Jesus? What is required of us now?

- Read: John 8:31-47
- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

- Read: John 8:31-47
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
