Sermon Meditations: The Redemptive Future

Monday

- Open in prayer
- Read: Genesis 49:1-27 (with special focus on 8-12)
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's first point was "Our champion is coming!" What do these verses tell us about Jesus? (he will rule as a king, be fearsome for his people, be worshipped and served, his reign is eternal, and we shall be abundantly blessed by it!).
- Close in prayer

Tuesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: Genesis 49:1-27 (with special focus on 22-26)
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's second point was "Our champion will defend and bless his people!"
- Close in prayer

Wednesday

- Open in prayer
- Read: John 2:1-12; Psalm 23 and John 10:1-21 (or 1-6 and 11-16 if you're short on time)
- Meditation: Pastor Matt's didn't have a third point this week, but there are a few places in Scripture that will look back to these verses and are worth meditating on today. Do you see how Jesus' miracle at Cana (John 2) was a fulfillment of the abundance of wine promised when the Messiah would come? What are some things we know are true because Christ is our Shepherd (How is he our Shepherd, Psalm 23 and John 10)?

- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior and how we ought to live in the world as followers of Christ?
