**Instruction:** Whatever time of day works best each day for you or your family, use the prompts below to spend a few minutes together in prayer and the Word. Open and close each session with a simple prayer. Use the questions for meditation or discussion.

**Sermon Meditations: The Word Became Flesh**

Monday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 1:1-18 (focus on vs. 14-18)
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's first point on Sunday was, "Christ Dwells Among Us." What is the reason that Christ came to dwell among us? How is Jesus able to sympathize with our struggles? How has Christ shown us the glory of the Father? Christ was in the flesh, so what are the examples he gives us for how we should live?
- Close in Prayer

Tuesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 1:1-18 (focus on vs. 14-18)
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's second point on Sunday was, "Christ is Grace and Truth." Christ shows us the grace of God. How? What does it mean that he gives us grace and that there is more grace beyond that? How does the Law point us to Christ?
- Close in Prayer

Wednesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 1:1-18 (focus on vs. 14-18)
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's last point on Sunday was, "Christ Reveals the Father." How does Christ show us what the Father is like? Name some examples from the gospels that show how Christ interacts with sinners. How do we receive Christ as Lord and Savior? Will we ever see God face to face? (Answer Revelation 22:3-5)

Thursday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Romans 5:12-21
- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?
- Close in Prayer

Friday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: Romans 5:12-21
- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior?
