Sermon Meditations: Life From God

Monday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 1:1-14 (focus on vs. 4-5)
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's first point on Sunday was, "Look to Christ as the Source of Life." Name the ways we have life from Christ. Why did Christ need to condescend to bring us life? How do we receive the eternal life that Jesus offers us?
- Close in Prayer

Tuesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 1:1-14 (focus on vs. 4-5)
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's second point on Sunday was, "Follow Christ as the Light of the World." What is darkness referring to in the world today? How does Christ bring light to this dark world? How does Christ lead us as light? What means does he use to bring light into our lives?

Wednesday

- Open in Prayer
- Read: John 1:1-14 (focus on vs. 4-5)
- Meditation: Pastor Nathan's last point on Sunday was, "Trust Christ- for Darkness Will Not Prevail." What encouragement do we get from, "the darkness has not overcome the light"? How did darkness try to prevail against Christ, and how did he overcome it? If Christ overcame darkness what does this mean for those who are "in him" by faith?

- Meditation: What questions do you have about this text? Is there anything confusing or curious? Does anything stand out as important?

Friday

- Meditation: Westminster Shorter Catechism Question 4 asks, "What do the Scriptures principally teach?" Answer: "The Scriptures principally teach what man is to believe concerning God and what duty God requires of man." What does this passage teach us about God's character and work? What does it teach us about our own hearts and need for a Savior?
