7:11	Turned the temple into a robber's den (hideout)	Mk 11:17	Turned the temple into a robber's den (hideout)
7:12-15	Jeremiah pronounces destruction of the temple	Mk 13:1-2	Jesus pronounces destruction of the temple (Tuesday)
26:8	Reaction to the sermon – "You shall die."	Mk. 11:18	Reaction to his teaching – they "were seeking a way to destroy him"
