

“let the King and Haman come today...” Esther 5:4

Remember, we read Hebrew right to left...

יָבוֹא הַמֶּלֶךְ וְהָמָן הַיּוֹם

today and Haman the King come

Remembering that Hebrew was originally only consonants, here are the consonants
in the divine name...

יהוה

HWHY (or, left to right: YHWH)

This is called the tetragrammaton (four letters). From it we get
the English transliterations, Yahweh and Jehovah.
