Prayer of Spiritual Communion

(when attendance at Holy Communion is impossible).

In union, blessed Jesus, with the faithful gathered at every altar of your Church where your blessed Body and Blood are offered this day, I long to offer you praise and thanksgiving, for creation and all the blessings of this life, for the redemption won for us by your life, death, and resurrection, for the means of grace and the hope of glory. As I cannot receive communion at this time, I pray you to come into my heart, my soul, and my mind. Grant me, Lord, to evermore dwell in you, and you in me. Let nothing separate me from you and the communion of your Church, and let me serve you in this life until, by your grace, I come to your glorious kingdom and unending peace. Amen.

For one who is sick

O merciful Father, who has taught us in your Holy Word that you do not willingly afflict us: Look with pity on our *brother/sister* _____ for whom our prayers are offered. Remember *him*, O Lord, in mercy. Nourish *his* soul in patience, comfort *him* with a sense of your goodness, lift up your countenance upon *him*, and give *him* peace, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
