

ANGEL TREE



Arden Presbyterian Church is participating in Angel Tree, a ministry of Prison Fellowship providing gifts for children of prisoners. Gift wishes are written on paper angels and hung as decorations on the Christmas tree located in the narthex. Church members and friends buy these gifts and other items found on this flyer.

Several types of decorations are found on our tree. Each child is represented by one angel. Stars represent a Walmart gift card for caregivers for \$25.00. Circles represent cash donations. Gifts of food to fill baskets for each family are also needed.

It is essential that each angel be signed out with the recipient's name and code number and the donor's name and phone number. **After choosing a tag, be sure to stop at the Angel Tree table to have this information recorded.** Please see reverse side regarding where and when to bring your donations. All donations and gifts are due **Dec. 15th**.

In addition, volunteers are needed on Thursday, **December 19th** to pack food baskets and gifts and on Saturday, **December 21st**, to deliver the baskets and gifts. Your help is needed for every aspect of the Angel Tree.

Providing a gift on behalf of an absent parent, in the name of Jesus, may open hearts to receive the most important gift of all – the one God gave to provide us with salvation and forgiveness of sins.
