

ANGEL TREE PARTICIPANTS: THANK YOU FOR GIVING!!

Here are some guidelines and information to help you with your Angel Tree giving.

1. Choose an angel from the tree in the Sanctuary lobby and register your angel at the table. Helpers at the Angel Tree tables can assist.
2. The amount spent for each gift should not exceed \$30. Choose either clothing OR a fun gift. If more than one item is listed on your Angel, these are just suggestions.
3. Please leave the sales tag on clothing items indicating name of store where purchased (minus the price paid) in case exchange is necessary and include a gift receipt with the package. Wrap each gift and tag it with your “Angel”. Wrap any child's gift card in a box. Make sure the child’s name and code number is on each tag. **DO NOT** put your name or Arden Presbyterian on the gift because it is actually coming from the parent in prison.
4. Return your gift to the Angel Tree location on Angel Tree Sundays or to the Chapel. **Bring all gifts to the church no later than Sunday, December 15.**
5. **Food donations will be taken this year!** They may be brought to the church each of the Sundays and placed in the narthex. The deadline for food donations is December 15.
6. If you are giving a **monetary donation**, you may leave a check or cash at the Angel Tree table during Angel Tree Sundays or put into the offering plate. Checks should be made out to “Arden Presbyterian Church” and marked “Angel Tree” on the memo line. You may also drop off checks at the Administration Building to Dan Berger.
7. We will **assemble** Angel Tree **baskets** (including the wrapped gifts and food) on Thursday, **December 19** at 9:30 AM. Please sign up if you would like to be involved.
8. We will be delivering the gifts and food baskets on Saturday, **December 21** from 9:30 a.m.– 12:00 p.m. If you have signed up to help deliver, please meet in the youth classroom on the lower level of the Sanctuary at 9:00.



Please have your gifts at the church by December 15. Also, please pray for these children and their families, as this is a ministry and a time of healing for many.
