#### The Fear of the Lord

How's your "FEAR" level for 2024? Some people are saying, "The 2024 election could be the end of democracy as we know it." (William Becker) and others, "The greatest economic collapse in our life-time will occur in 2024." (Harry Dent) What elicits fear in your heart?

Scripture tells us that "The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?" Psalm 27:1

But the Bible also tells us there is **ONE** to be feared and that is a good thing to "fear" HIM. And this good "fear" should be our normal experience every day for every year and not just 2024.





There's nothing that compares to a ride in the church van - especially with our super driver Harold Ivey!




