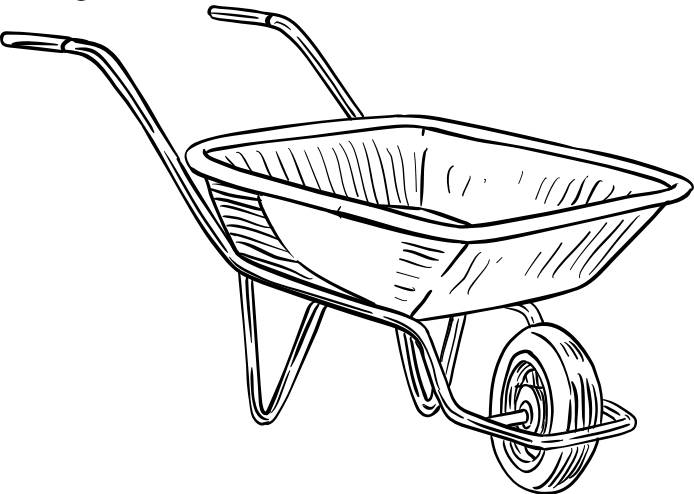
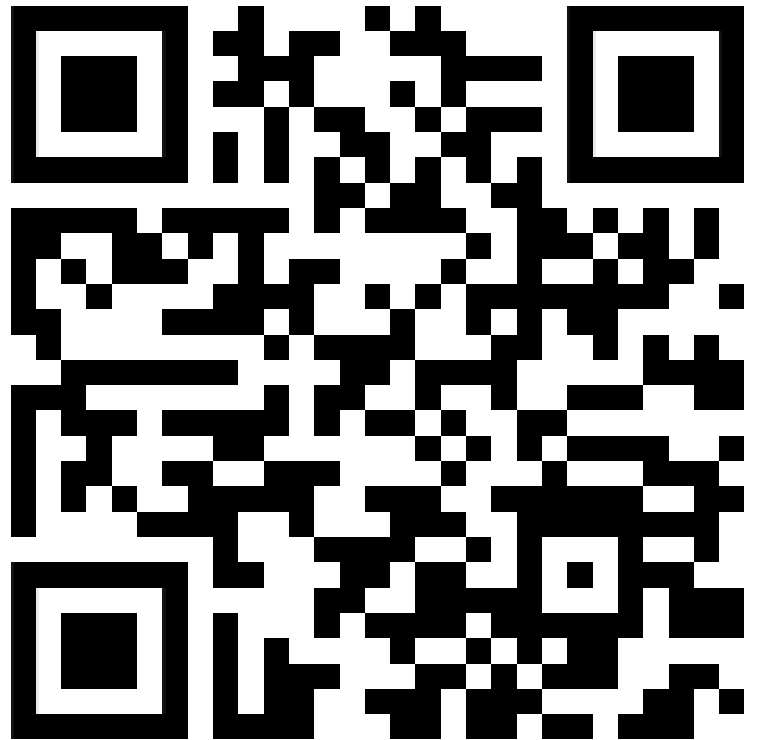

What will my student be doing to serve this year?

This year's work project will be at the Black Mountain Children's home campus.
