HIDING GOD'S WORD IN YOUR HEART Memorize Romans 12:1-2. The verses below are taken from the Legacy Standard Bible, but you can use whatever version you like.

1 Therefore I exhort you, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a sacrifice-- living, holy, [and] pleasing to God, [which is] your spiritual service of worship.

2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may approve what the will of God is, that which is good and pleasing and perfect."

Romans 12:1-2, LSB

READING In *The True Woman*, read chapters 1 and 2: Her Time and Standard (pgs 25-65).

QUESTIONS -- RECORD THESE IN YOUR JOURNAL

1. Begin by asking yourself if you are truly "in the faith" (2 Corinthians 13:5) and trusting in Jesus Christ alone, His sinless life, and atoning sacrifice for your salvation? Do you see the marks of repentance and grace in your life? *Write a statement of your faith at the beginning of your journal.*

Do you have a clear understanding of the gospel, or are you uncertain? If this is the case, please do speak with your small group leader or any one of the EWH teachers privately for help with this.

2. How do the values and characteristics of "our time" distract or discourage you from living to the glory of God?

3. Read Acts 17:26-28 and reflect on the truth that God sovereignly determined the time in history and the place on the planet where you would live. Do the words, "In Him we live and move and have our being," influence the way you live day to day? Should they? How? Record your thoughts.

4. What is meant by the statement that the true woman and the new woman are both *products of theology*? What are the characteristics of each?

5. What examples of true women stood out to you the most in these chapters? Compare the marks of immaturity and maturity in a woman. How is maturity forged in the life of a believing woman?
