HIDING GOD'S WORD IN YOUR HEART Memorize Romans 12:1-2. The verses below are taken from the Legacy Standard Bible, but you can use whatever version you like.

1 Therefore I exhort you, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a sacrifice-- living, holy, [and] pleasing to God, [which is] your spiritual service of worship.

2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may approve what the will of God is, that which is good and pleasing and perfect."
Romans 12:1-2, LSB

READING In *The True Woman*, read chapter 3: A Recipient of Redemption (pgs 67-88).

QUESTIONS -- RECORD THESE IN YOUR JOURNAL

1. When you think of your identity (who you are), what are the first things that pop into your mind?
2. The first sentence of chapter 3 says, "As a redeemed daughter of the King of Kings, the Christian woman has a new identity." What does "redeemed" mean? See Strong's G3084 if you are using *Blue Letter Bible*.
3. Susan Hunt talks about God's sovereignty in three areas. List the 3 areas and give a brief explanation of what she means. Does this teaching bring you comfort? Why or why not?
4. What do you think is the connection between God's sovereignty and your identity?
5. To prepare for Wednesday night's teaching session, read 1 Peter 1:1-2:12. See if you can pick out some facts about our identity as Christians.
