QUESTIONS -- RECORD THESE IN YOUR JOURNAL

1. How is *piety* defined in this chapter?
2. In your own words, describe the passage and pursuit of piety found on pgs 159-161. What are your greatest needs in this area? What practical steps can you take to mature in this virtue?
3. Reread de Tocqueville's quote about gender differences on pgs 154-155. What is the danger of "feminizing" piety? Should we evaluate men's spirituality on a female scale? How do you see this in our culture? In the church?
4. Reread the section *A Picture of Piety* on pgs 157-159. Then meditate on Matthew 26:6-13 and ask yourself how you can demonstrate your love for your Father and the Son with holy abandon?
5. Further, read Colossians 3:12-14. How do these verses teaching love for others relate to Matthew 26:6-13 and our love for God?
