QUESTIONS -- RECORD THESE IN YOUR JOURNAL

Webster's Revised Unabridged Dictionary defines *purity* as "Freedom from foreign admixture or deleterious matter; as, the purity of water, of wine, of drugs, of metals... Cleanness; freedom from foulness or dirt... Freedom from guilt or the defilement of sin; innocence; chastity; as, purity of heart or of life."

A straightforward Scriptural definition of *purity* references "the state of being free from sin, moral corruption, and defilement. It encompasses both the inner condition of the heart and the outward actions that reflect a life aligned with God's standards. Purity is often associated with holiness, righteousness, and sanctification, and it is a recurring theme throughout Scripture, emphasizing the importance of living a life that is pleasing to God" (Bible Hub: Purity).

1. What are the blessings of having a pure heart according to Psalm 24:3-6 and Matthew 5:8?
2. Read and think about 2 Timothy 2:20-22. What does this metaphor mean? How can a Christian cleanse herself? What are some examples of "youthful lusts" that we should flee?
3. Read Titus 3:3-8. If you have put your faith in Jesus and repented of your sins, share some ways that your life is different now.
