HIDING GOD'S WORD IN YOUR HEART Memorize Isaiah 66:2. The verses below are taken from the Legacy Standard Bible, but you can use whatever version you like.

*“For My hand made all these things,
Thus all these things came into being,” declares Yahweh.
“But to this one I will look,
To him who is humble and contrite of spirit, and who trembles at My word.”
Isaiah 66:2 LSB*

READING In *The True Woman*, read chapter 11: Submission (pgs 202-224).

QUESTIONS -- RECORD THESE IN YOUR JOURNAL

1. Susan Hunt describes submission as "*the defining virtue of the defining virtues.*" After reading the chapter, why do you think she said this?
2. But, submission, as Susan says, does not center around our behaviors, but around our character. What do you think she meant by this? What attitude of our heart is essential to biblical submission? Read Proverbs 18:12; Zephaniah 2:3; Ephesians 4:1-2; Philippians 2:3; and 1 Peter 5:5. Then record what you learn.
3. Reread pgs 206-207, then record the 5 points under what Hunt correctly describes as the biblical position (or theological position) on submission. These are extremely important for women to know and understand thoroughly. Do you have questions about the meaning of any of these?
4. Have you ever been disappointed by a man in leadership over you (whether a husband, church leader, or father)? Have you been able to forgive him? Or, does the issue keep surfacing over and over in your mind? If this is the case, is it possible that the problem might stem from your own heart? Can you ask God to show you any hidden, sinful attitudes and to help you overcome them by grace?
5. Commit to pray for the men in your life. Use Colossians 1:9-12 as an example for your prayer, rather than listing ways God should change them.
6. Look through this important chapter one more time. Write down the most important thing (or things) you have learned and the thing (or things) you need to change :)
7. Have you memorized the verse at the top of the page? If you haven't, commit to memorizing it before our next session.
