

Church Music Positions

Pianist/Accompanist

- Accompany congregation singing for Lord's Day worship and other occasional worship services. (Weekly 10:00 AM Sunday Worship)
- Accompany the Senior Choir. (Weekly Wednesday rehearsals 7-8:30 PM, and Sunday morning worship)
- Occasionally accompany soloists/special music for worship.
- Accompany occasional funeral/wedding services.
- Organist/Pianist/Accompanist welcome to apply.

Music/Choir Director

- Oversee, develop, and provide leadership for the totality of congregation's music ministry: senior choir, children's choir, bell choir.
- Rehearse the senior choir, children's choir, bell choir, and provide direction to occasional soloists and special music groups.
- Work with the pastor and other church staff in the selection of music for congregational worship and preparation of the service bulletin.
- Organize and administrate the music library.
- Encourage congregational singing and use of appropriate vocal and instrumental music in the conduct of corporate worship for Sundays, special services, including children's and youth events.
