Key Passage to Memorize & Meditate Upon: Hebrews 11:8-10 (LSB) By faith Abraham, when he was called, obeyed by going out to a place which he was to receive for an inheritance; and he went out, not knowing where he was going.⁹ By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a foreign land, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, fellow heirs of the same promise,¹⁰ for he was looking for the city which has foundations, whose architect and builder is God.
